



# Planning Permission

**Planning permission approval needs to be in place before a decision is made by LEADER Local Action Group.**

If a project involves building works or a change of use it may need planning permission.

You can find this out from your Local Planning Authority (LPA). In Oxfordshire they are:

## **If planning permission is required**

If it does need planning permission then applicants need to have submitted their planning permission application before they can submit a full application to LEADER. The planning permission approval needs to be in place before a decision is made by LEADER Local Action Group.

Please take into account how long this process can take and how it might affect your application to LEADER.

## **If planning permission is not required**

If planning permission is not required for the project but it does involve building work of any kind or a change of use, a signed letter/email from the Local Planning Authority must be provided confirming this.

Any other consents and licenses needed for a project such as environmental licenses or listed building consents must be provided with the full application.
