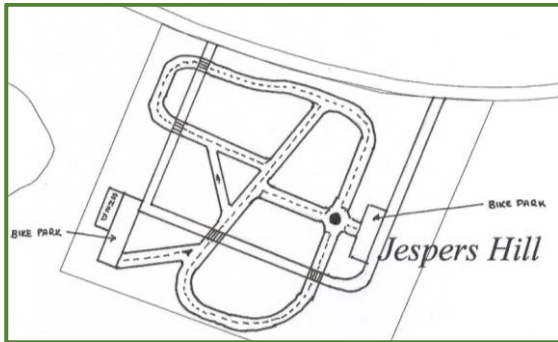


Training Cycle Park, Faringdon Farcycles



Grant: £42,354 (90%)

Farcycles is a voluntary cycle group based in Faringdon that promotes cycling for all. A grant from LEADER will enable them to build a training cycle park, free to the whole community.

The aim of the park is to support children and vulnerable adults to be confident cyclists. This will promote healthier living, less traffic and community cohesion. It will be a pioneering project, with very few facilities like this found elsewhere in the country.

Work will start on the park in 2019 and should be finished by mid – 2019.

Priority: (4) *Provide rural services*

Outputs over 3 years: *Benefit the rural population of Faringdon – 7,121*
